## Parking Lease Program

There are fourteen parking spaces on the property that are leased on an annual basis from the HOA. The annual parking space lease lottery will be held prior to the meeting on June 19<sup>th</sup>.

The current lease period ends June 30<sup>th</sup>. If you are interested in having your name included in the annual lottery, you must complete and submit an application (or renewal application) found on the website prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>. Note that your HOA account must be current and in good standing to qualify for the lottery.

## Community Bulletin Board

Please make note of the following rules reminders:

Balconies: Nothing other than plants, patio furniture and bicycles can be stored on the balconies. Do not leave bags of recycling, garbage, toys, or storage boxes and bins on your balcony. Please do NOT hang blankets, clothes, towels, or other items over the railings, even if you are just "airing them out." Clothes drying racks are also prohibited.

Window Coverings/Screens: The association's guidelines state that window coverings must be white or off-white if they face the common areas. Screens are required on all windows. Both window coverings and screens must be in good condition without tears or broken slats. Owners are responsible for the maintenance and replacement of the screens and window coverings.

Patio Maintenance: All trees, shrubs, and vines in the patio area must be kept at least three' from the roof and off of the fencing. Trees that are overgrown onto the walkways create a pedestrian safety issue. Do not dispose of any yard clippings, old plants, or tree branches in the common area as this may result in a violation and fines.
